**Overview**: All Cranberry Township Community Chest ("CTCC") 50/50 Raffle tickets, transactions, participants, purchasers and winners are subject to these Official Rules, and to all applicable statutes, rules and regulations, including but not limited to the Pennsylvania Small Games of Chance Act, Licensing Law, the Rules and Regulations adopted pursuant thereto, and all other applicable rules and regulations adopted by any regulatory and/or enforcement agency having jurisdiction with respect to the activities to which these Official Rules apply.

**Ticket Purchase**: The CTCC 50/50 Raffle fundraiser will be conducted at the 2025 CTCC Community Days. Raffle tickets can be purchased in person at the CTCC Info Booth and Raffle Booth during operating hours on July 10, July 11, and July 12, 2025. The winning ticket number will be drawn on Saturday, July 12, 2025 at 7:45pm and announced at the Rotary Amphitheater in Community Park (111 Ernie Mashuda Drive, Cranberry Township, PA 16066). The winner does not need to be present to

**Ticket Prices:** Tickets may be purchased with cash only (United States (\$) Dollars) as follows:

Each ticket is a receipt for the entrant and represents one (1) entry for the raffle and is not eligible for any past or future raffle drawings. CTCC is not responsible for printing errors in any raffle-related material or any misdirected, incomplete, lost, late, or illegible tickets or other errors or problems that may limit the entrant's ability to participate in or win the raffle. False or deceptive entries or acts will render the buyer ineligible. Entrants may purchase as many tickets as they wish, subject to availability. No refunds will be made, except as otherwise determined by CTCC in its sole discretion. Raffle ticket purchases are not tax deductible.

**Eligibility**: CTCC 50/50 Raffle fundraiser is open to all attendees age eighteen (18) or older as of the date of entry. By purchasing a Raffle ticket, the entrant agrees to abide by all terms of the Official Rules applicable thereto and is subject to all Federal, State, Local and Municipal Laws and Regulations. CTCC Board of Directors, Board of Supervisors, Cranberry Township Executive Staff, and their immediate family members (defined for these purposes as including spouse and children) and individuals living in the same household, are not eligible to participate or win.

**Drawing**: The winning ticket number will be selected by random drawing on Saturday, July 12, 2025 at 7:45PM at the Rotary Amphitheater in Community Park (111 Ernie Mashuda Drive, Cranberry Township, PA 16066). The winner does not need to be present to claim the prize. One (1) winner will be chosen out of the pool of purchased tickets for the raffle. The decisions of CTCC are final and binding on all matters relating to the raffle.

**Winner Notification**: The winning ticket will be announced at the Rotary Amphitheater on Saturday, July 12, 2025, at 7:45PM. The winner will be notified via phone and/or email immediately following the live drawing announcement.

Prize: The prize is monetary, and the prize amount is 50% of earnings from total raffle tickets sold. The winning prize, in the form of a check, shall be paid to the Raffle winner within 5 business days of the claim date. The winner, whether in person or not at the time of announcement, must come to the Cranberry Township Municipal Center (2525 Rochester Road, Suite 600, Cranberry Township, PA 16066) and complete all required paperwork to receive their prize. Requirements for prize pickup include presenting raffle ticket with matching winning number, presenting a valid (not expired), approved form of government issued photo ID (driver's license, non-driver photo ID, U.S. Passport, U.S. Passport Card, U.S. Military ID Card), and must sign W2-G tax form. The CTCC Raffle winner will have until 5 business days following the announcement of the 50/50 Raffle winner to claim their prize. If a prize remains unclaimed after 5 business days following the announcement of the 50/50 Raffle winner, the unclaimed prize money will be donated back to CTCC.

The CTCC 50/50 Raffle fundraiser is governed by Pennsylvania law under Small Games of Chance License #SGC05435. All winners will be subject to the IRS rules and regulations regarding gambling winnings.

The Raffle winner assumes all responsibility for any state, county or Federal taxes, fees or withholdings. The Winner is advised to consult their own tax advisor(s) with respect to the liabilities that may arise from winning a prize in the Raffle. No substitutes for prizes are allowed. Potential Raffle winners may waive their right to receive a prize (i.e., decline the prize), at which time the prize from that drawing date will be forfeited and the prize money will be donated to CTCC.

CTCC and the Township of Cranberry are not responsible for any lost or stolen 50/50 Raffle tickets.

**Additional Conditions:** By purchasing a Raffle ticket, buyers agree to release and hold harmless CTCC and the Township of Cranberry, and each of their respective supervisors, employees, directors, officers, affiliates, representatives, agents, successors, and assigns (collectively, "Released Parties")

against any and all liability claims or actions of any kind whatsoever arising directly or indirectly for injuries (including death), damages or losses to persons and property, which may be sustained in connection with the receipt or use of any prize, or while preparing for, participating in, or traveling to any prize-related activity. CTCC, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering within the entry process or otherwise in violation of the official Rules. CTCC further reserves the right to cancel, terminate or modify the Raffle for any reason, including, but not limited to if any Raffle is not capable of completion as planned, including but not limited to, infection by tampering, unauthorized intervention or technical failures of any sort, fraud, or acts of God. Released Parties make no warranty, guaranty or representation of any kind concerning any prize and disclaim any implied warranty. All disputes will be resolved under applicable U.S. Laws in Cranberry Township, County of Butler, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, without reference to its conflicts of law principles.

Any attempt to deliberately damage or undermine the legitimate operation of any Raffle may be in violation of criminal and civil laws and will result in disqualification from participation in the Raffle.
